Dear Parents and Carers,

We had another great week in Apple class. You may have noticed Mrs Carter has been working with us and today we had Mrs Mackney working with us. This is because Mrs Southon has unfortunately not been able to come to school, but is hoping to be back with us as soon as possible. She is still keeping in touch with us to make sure we're doing the things she has planned for us!

In phonics this week, we have been focusing on learning some trigraphs (3 letters, 1 sound). We will be continuing with this next week.

In English, we have started the imitation stage of our new talk for writing story 'Stick Man'. The children have been using the class story map to retell the story with actions. Once they are familiar with the story, we will be moving on to the innovation stage.

In maths, we have been focusing on recognising and sequencing numbers. This is a great activity that builds on what they have learnt during their time in school.

In Science, we have been focusing on learning about the body. We drew around one of the children in the class and then used this outline to label the different parts of the body.

In RE, the children have been learning about Christianity. They were able to explore their five senses (sight, hearing, touch, smell and taste) and consider what we would be able to see, hear, touch, smell and taste if we visited a Church.
