Dear Rowan parents and carers,

This week in Rowan Class we have been identifying and using adjectives, adverbs, verbs and prepositions. We wrote sentences about Leafman describing the setting he is in, what he is doing in the setting, how he is doing it and where he is doing it: *Leafman is quickly flying over the misty mountains.*

In Maths this week we have been counting in 2's and 5's. We discovered that we can count things in pairs in 2's-like socks and gloves. We coloured in every number in the 5 times table on our number squares and discovered a pattern: 5, 10, 15, 20- the ones digit will always be 5 or 0.

In Science this week we learnt about healthy eating and designed our own healthy meals. We drew our food items on our plate templates; we made sure we included lots of vegetables as well protein and some carbohydrates.

We painted lily pond pictures in Art this week, inspired by Claude Monet's own painting and the piece of music 'The Swan' from 'Carnival of the Animals'. We followed a special painting guide that showed us some of the brush techniques and colours that Claude Monet used. We used a dabbing motion for the leaves and a gliding motion to create our water and swan.
