Dear Parents and Carers,

The children have shown their great maths reasoning skills across the week. We have continued our learning with place value. In particular, we have been using number lines up to 1000. We have had the base 10 equipment out to show what 1, 10 or 100 more or less would look like. We ended the week with comparing objects up to 1000.

In English, we have been continuing our work on character descriptions, looking particularly at the emperor. We then ended the week with looking at what most transformation stories need and boxing up our story.

In topic, we became hunters and gatherers. We had to find our own food through hunting animals and gathering up fruits, nuts and plants. The children then sorted them into each season and tried to look at what meals we would be able to make with our findings.

Please remember to bring your purple reading diaries and books into school on Fridays. This will enable us to change them and make sure they are still reading the correct levels.

We continue to ask that rucksacks are not brought into school as children only need lunch boxes, reading diaries and books (Fridays) and a coat.
