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This week in maths we have finished our unit on place value. The children have shown their amazing reasoning and

problem solving skills throughout the week and have been willing to give everything a go. We have been comparing different 2-digit and 3-digit numbers then ordering them from greatest to smallest. We also compared and ordered different measurements. Next week we begin our calculations unit on addition and subtraction.

In English, we have been working on writing our own hot write stories. The children began the week by drawing a story map to help them remember their story. The children have tried hard to ensure they have remembered the key punctuation and capital letters on top of their story structure and key features.

In topic and art, we explored cave paintings and discussed where they can be found around the world. The children were full of ideas about why they were created and how they were created. The classroom was then transformed into a cave and the children had the opportunity to create their own cave art.
