Dear Parents and Carers,

What a wonderful week we have had in Poplar Class! The children have come back ready to learn and have shown us all what amazing learners they are.

In maths this week we have spent some time recapping some of the year 2 objectives to see what they could remember. We have focussed on place value looking at tens and ones in each number. We used the maths equipment to show how many of each we had.

In English we have written our own transformation stories and then Mrs Hewitt and Mrs B found some strange items in our classroom. They looked like they may have come from China.
