This week in maths we have continued our addition and subtraction unit. We have recapped some learning from year 2 as well as introduced some new objectives. We have been adding 3 digits and 1 digits using exchanging. Can your child tell you what we mean by exchanging? We have also begun subtracting 1-digits from 2 and 3-digit numbers.

In English, we have continued learning about non-fiction recounts. The children have looked at the structure of a recount as well as time connectives and how we write in chronological order. The children have then written a recount from the perspective of a Stone Age person, using our learning from topic.

We celebrate the children's hard work on their homework this week also! There were some amazing pieces! The children enjoyed being able to discuss what they had done and what they had learnt from it.
